PRESS RELEASE KYU 20TH GRADUATION CEREMONY.

1. The 20th graduation will be held on 10th, 11th, 12th and 13th December 2024.
2. Venue for the ceremony will be EAST END PITCH.
3. Gates and Parking areas to be used:-
 - a. **Graduands;**
 - i. Graduands who will use Kyambogo road will park at cricket oval grounds and will access the parking through cricket oval gate. After parking they will access the venue through Fisher road.
 - ii. Graduands who will use Northern by pass, East African road, Ntinda-Kiwatule road and enter through Northern gate (Kabaka's gate) will park at Peace Park grounds.
 - iii. Graduands who will use Ntinda-Kiwatule road and enter through National Council for Higher Education (NCHE) road will as well park at Peace park grounds and multipurpose science building parking yard.
 - iv. Note. Eastern gate (Banda gate) will not be used by the graduands. It's reserved for University VIPS and service providers for the three days of the function from 05a.m.- 02p.m.

b. University Staff;

- i. Staff who will use western gate will drive through Fisher road and connect to Harlow road and access the parking at Central Library or Barclays parking, accessed through the gate opposite Faculty of Agriculture.

- ii. Staff who will use Northern gate (Kabaka's gate) will access Central Library through spring road.

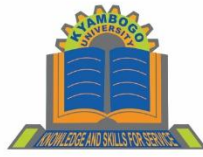
c. VVIPs;

All will park at Senate building parking yard. i.e the Chief Guest, Chairperson Council, Vice Chairperson Council, Chancellor, Vice Chancellor and deputies, University Secretary, Bursar and Chief Human Resources.

d. VIPS;

- i. All will park at Technical Teacher Education (TTE) or Central Teaching Facility (CTF) parking yards. Those who will use Eastern gate and Main gate will use Fisher road and connect to Harlow road and access the parkings.
 - ii. Those who will use Kabaka gate will use spring road and access the Parking yards at CTF and TTE.
4. **Invitation cards and Stickers;** all graduands and invited guest must carry along the invitation card and car sticker. The invitation card allow only the graduand and two parents/guardians. Only invitation cards and stickers holders will be allowed entry in the University for the four days of graduation starting 05:00a.m. - 02:00p.m.
5. **Vendors;** only accredited Vendors will be allowed at the gazetted places for vending within the University as guided by estates and security and must not be near the Main venue for graduation.
