On submission of the online application, printout the application form, attach copies of the equated academic documents and submit them to Kyambogo University (Admissions Office, Block 2 - Room 3) not later than the closing date for receiving online applications. Ugandan nationals must submit a printed application form and attach **Original Certified Copies** of their academic documents to **ADMISSIONS OFFICE**, **BLOCK 2 - ROOM 3**. The deadline for receiving online application forms is **Friday 9**th **January 2026 at Midnight**.
